2007 Budget was accepted.

This is a tight and lean budget. Salaries remain the same. We added a few items especially in the area of Christian Education, but on the whole, we kept close to our 2006 totals., adding only a little more than \$1000 over last year. We had some income last year from using restricted funds to overcome a budget error; this year's income figures are based on normal income sources. Bottom line is we are looking at a shortfall of almost \$10,000.
